

DE BERGE GUESTHOUSE



De Berge is a brand new and custom built guest house with magnificent blue gum tree furniture.

We have 12 en-suite double rooms, 9 with single beds (two in each room) and 3 with double beds. Each room is equipped with a TV, fridge with mini bar, ceiling fan, air conditioning, coffee and tea making facilities.

Meals are served in the dining room and three course dinners are available on request (must be booked when making your reservation). There is also a braai room with a BBQ, as well as a bar, for guests to use. We also have conference-, fax-, function- and seminar facilities as well as safe parking (situated at the back of the building with an electric gate and your own remote).

Piketberg is situated in the Swartland with wheat and fruit farming as the main economical asset in this region. Situated near the Berg River and at the foot of the Piket Mountains we are in the heart of the Soft Fruit Farm Industry. Sightseeing tours can be arranged on these farms.

The Dutch Reformed Church building was designed by Otto Hager and was built in 1881 and is one of the primary tourist attractions. A wide variety of flowers such as pincushions and fountain flowers can be seen on the Goedverwacht Peerboom Route Hiking Trail. There is also an abundance of small wildlife to be seen on this trail.

Just outside of town, on the N7, you will find the Winkelshoek Wine Cellars with wine tasting facilities and wines of this region can be purchased after sampling. The picturesque farms on the Piket Mountains are worth a visit and on a clear day Table Mountain can be seen from the top of the mountain.

Location & Climate

Situated 130km from Cape Town, Piketberg is 60km from the nearest sea at Velddrif and 100km from the Cedarberg Wilderness Area. Sport facilities in town include: golf, tennis, bowls and a municipal swimming pool. We have a mediterranean climate, with hot dry summers and mild but wet winters. Coastal summer temperatures range from a comfortable 15°C (59F) to highs of 30°C (80.6F), with inland temperatures climbing 3 to 5 degrees higher. Summer is from late October to February, with long sunny days, ideal for visiting the Cape's world-class beaches or exploring the great outdoors. Coastal winters are cooler and often wet, with temperatures dropping to a mild 7°C at night (44.6F), and 18°C (64.4F) in the day. Inland you will find the nights colder but the days slightly warmer, with snow on some of the higher mountain peaks.
